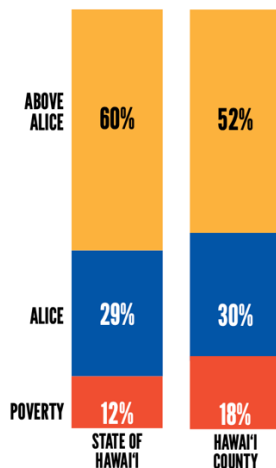

Percentage of ALICE Households in 2024



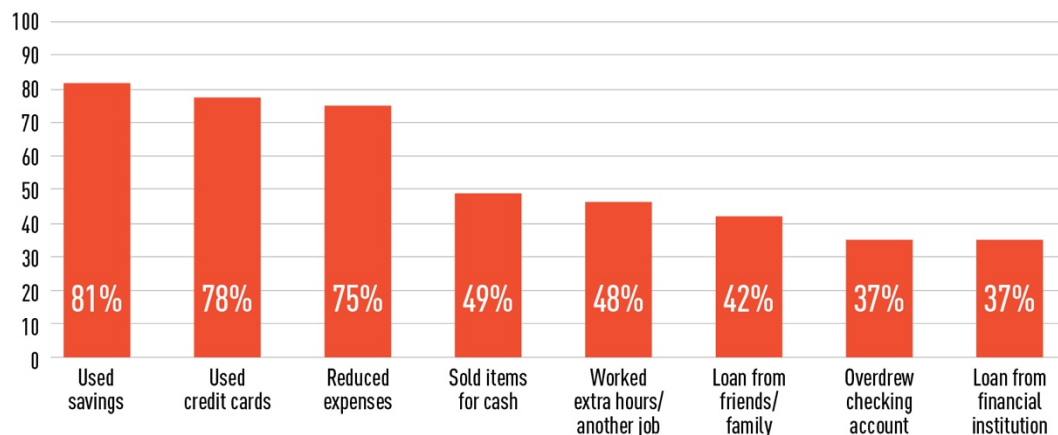

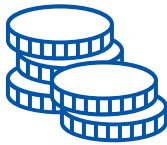
