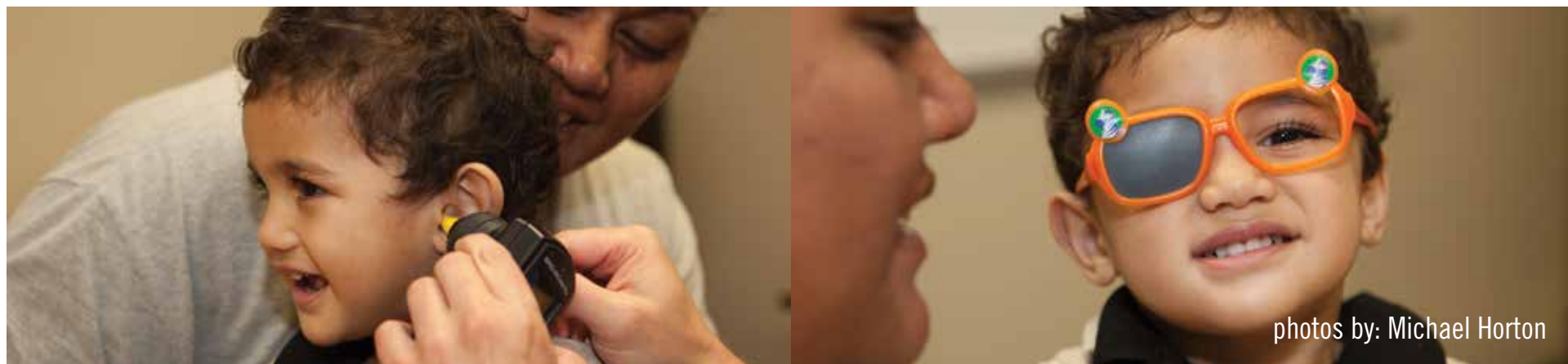

POVERTY PREVENTION An **INSTITUTE FOR HUMAN SERVICES** worker checks on the agency's Rooftop Training and Education Center, which produces 50-75 pounds of vegetables almost every week. This keeps food costs down and provides healthier meals. Last year, Aloha United Way funding assisted 6,642 adults and children in maintaining or accessing stable housing through a comprehensive network of housing assistance/stabilization, case management, rent/utility assistance, outreach and transitional shelter services.
