**VISION:** We believe individuals and families should have opportunities to increase their income, build savings, become financially stable, and achieve long-term economic independence

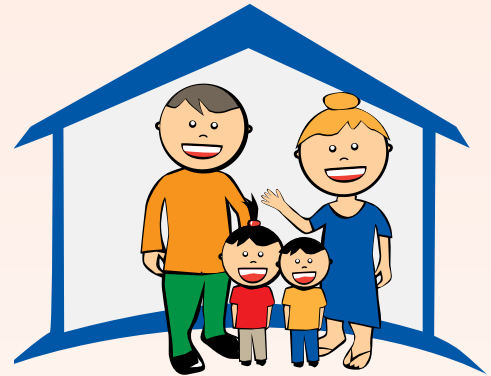
**PROGRESS:** How your donation helped in 2015



- 722 individuals received job training and skills building through workforce development services.



- 2,614 teenagers received pregnancy prevention education.



- 383 families received assistance in maintaining or accessing stable housing.

## **NEED:** Right here at home, on Oahu

- 1 in 3 Hawaii families have insufficient reserves to sustain their household if their source of income were interrupted for three months. The basic survival income required for a family of four is \$75,346 on Oahu. Few jobs in Hawaii pay a “living” wage.
- On any given night, 5,000 people are homeless on Oahu. We are making progress in securing permanent housing for those who remain unsheltered.
- In Hawaii, over the past 10 years the number of seniors 60 and older has increased by 72%, almost two and half times the rate of increase for the rest of the nation. Our Active Aging initiative helps effectively lower the cost of long-term care and the risk of seniors becoming homeless.
