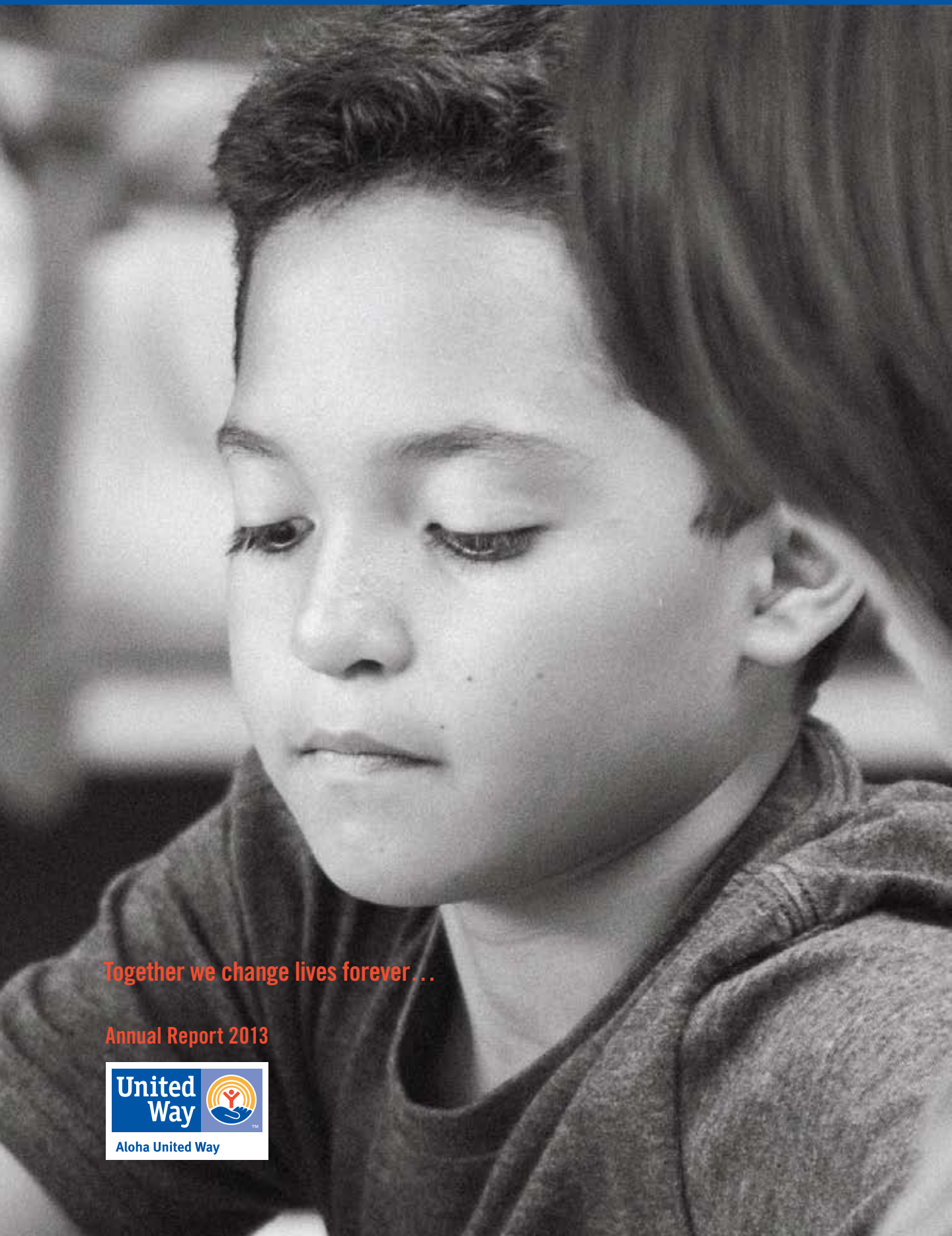

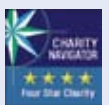

## EDUCATION

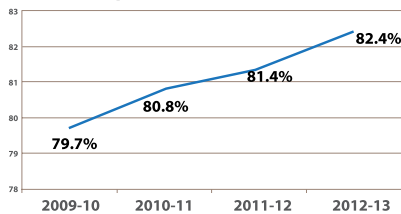
- Provided early childhood developmental screenings for 2,711 toddlers and young children (54% increase from 2012)
- Supported early learning and early literacy programs for 2,304 children and parents, and distributed 7,500+ books
- Assisted with the recruitment, selection, and training of 102 teachers in underprivileged, hard-to-staff public high schools

## HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

- Together, thirty-five partner agencies provided over 84,000 client service encounters in programs that helped to increase high-school graduation rates
- Through a variety of activities such as tutoring, mentoring, or athletic competition, community youth were supported to stay “on-track” and graduate

## POVERTY PREVENTION

- Assisted 6,642 adults and children in maintaining or accessing stable housing through a comprehensive network of housing assistance/stabilization, case management, rent/utility assistance, outreach, and transitional shelter services
- Supported work skills training and job supportive services for 581 individuals
- Provided pregnancy prevention information and dating abuse prevention training to 8,495 young adults
- Provided financial assistance to 977 low income seniors, adults with persistent mental illness, and elementary school students through a variety of case management, representative payee, and kids savings programs



## SAFETY NET SERVICES

- Assisted 1,012 seniors and their family caregivers with emergency respite services
- Assisted 2,406 domestic violence survivors with legal protections
- Offered support to 579 children, women, and men who were victims of domestic violence including case management, therapy, advocacy, shelter, safety planning, referrals, transportation, and other services
- Provided 134,000+ meals to 20,000+ hungry adults and children
- Provided medical/dental care for 6,843 individuals who were experiencing homelessness
- Provided legal services to 1,386 individuals in 578 households facing eviction or foreclosure

## YOUTH VENTURE

- 50 students forming 8 project teams, representing 11 Hawaii high schools led community service projects that were focused on issues including anti-bullying, peer mentoring, increasing the high school graduation rate, and reducing feelings of isolation among Hawaii’s kupuna

## FINANCIAL LITERACY EDUCATION

- Aloha United Way successfully brought the resources of the FINRA Foundation to Oahu
- FINRA provides underserved Americans with the knowledge, skills and tools necessary for financial success
- In partnership with Hawaii Council on Economic Education and Hawaiian Community Assets, Aloha United Way provided training to over 60 participants in thoughtful, effective, and culturally relevant financial literacy education
- These participants, representing over 22 community agencies, are now well equipped to teach financial skills and literacy to at-risk youth, providing them the knowledge and foundation to think about personal finance and their futures

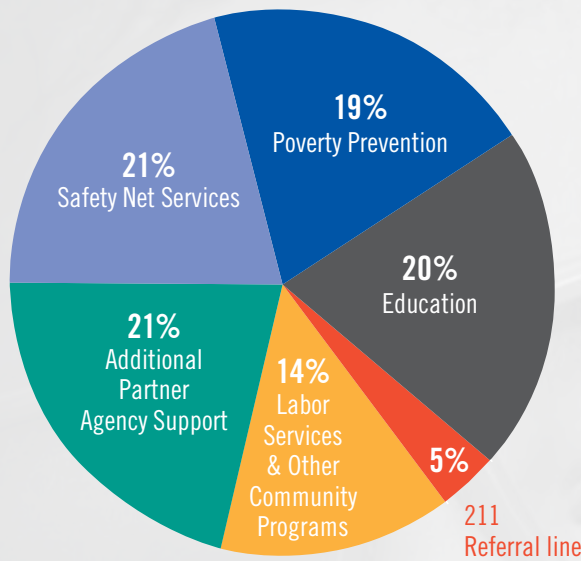

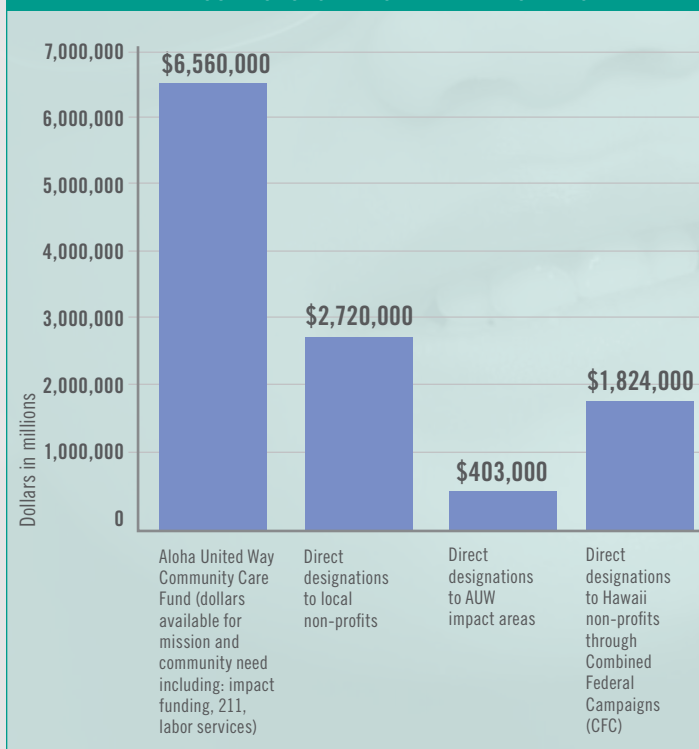

Note 1: Aloha United Way, Inc. (AUW) was contracted to manage the Hawaii-Pacific Area Combined Federal Campaign (CFC). In 2013 \$5,068,363 was raised in the CFC campaign. Of this amount, \$1,036,246 was designated to the AUW Federation, which is reflected in the figures reported above. Campaign expenses for the CFC campaign were \$302,451. The AUW Federation's share of those expenses was \$62,350 and were shared on a pro-rata basis by AUW and all members of the AUW Federation. Other than their share of expenses, AUW Federation members are not charged dues or any other service charges for their participation in the AUW Federation.

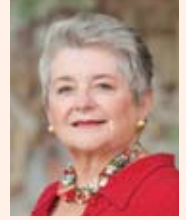
