Tackles root causes of financial instability for people working, doing everything they can to make ends meet yet struggling to get by each month. In early 2020, 42% of Hawai'i's population were considered Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed (ALICE) or below. Some experts believe this number will rise to 59% due to the COVID-19 pandemic (80114).

SAFETY NET

Provides basic human needs and support during emergency and crisis situations when people are the most vulnerable. Safety Net agencies strive to return households to stability (80100).
